

# DISCOVER THE BRITISH ISLES

**Day 1** Depart

**Day 2 Ireland**

Arrive in **Shannon, Ireland**. Meet your local guide who will transport you to **County Kerry**.

**Day 3 –Day 4 Ireland**

Journey through purple mountains, villages, rugged coastlines, bog land, and green valleys that make the **Ring of Kerry**, Ireland's most breathtaking scenery. Visit the **Bog village** and get a glimpse into the 18<sup>th</sup> century rural life in Ireland. Continue your trip to Dublin on day 4 stopping to visit the **Blarney Stone**, which is said to endow whoever kisses it the eternal gift of eloquence, "the gift of gab"!



**Day 5 – Ireland**

Take a guided tour of **Dublin**, visiting **Phoenix Park**, a huge national garden that houses the largest herds of deer in Ireland and the

residence of Ireland's president, **St. Patrick's Cathedral**, the largest church in the country which was built in the early 1200's, and many more beautiful sites. Later in the day visit the **Trinity College** to view the ancient **Book of Kells**, one of the most beautifully illuminated manuscripts in the world containing the four gospels.



**Day 6 – Day 7 Wales, Scotland**

Ferry across the Irish Sea to **Wales**. Visit **Beaumaris Castle**, the largest castle built by King Edward I in the 13<sup>th</sup> century. Travel through **Snowdonia National Park**, which covers 840 Square miles of the most beautiful and unspoiled countryside in North Western Wales. Spend the night in North Wales. On day 7, cross into England and drive through the scenic **Lake District** en route to **Scotland**.

**Day 8 Scotland**

Visit **Edinburgh Castle** on your guided tour of the Scottish capital. Stroll along the famous shopping area of **Princess Street**. In the evening, board an overnight train to **London**.



**Day 9 – Day 10 England**

Arrive in England's capital and Europe's largest city, **London**. Take a tour of this city's famous sites such as the **Big Ben, Piccadilly Circus, Buckingham Palace, St Paul's Cathedral and the Trafalgar Square**. Walk through the beautiful **Hyde Park** and the **Covent Garden** famous for its street performers.
